## Wednesday, October 2

have read: Genesis 18-19, 21-23

be ready to recite books of the Bible:

(all previous books, plus) Nehemiah, Esther, Job, Psalms, Proverbs

Be ready to recite:

*The Fourth Commandment*

Honor your father and your mother.

*What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.

## Wednesday, October 9

have read: Genesis 24-27

be ready to recite books of the Bible:

(all previous books, plus) Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations

Be ready to recite:

*The Fifth Commandment*

You shall not murder.

*What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

## Wednesday, October 16

have read: Genesis 27-32

be ready to recite books of the Bible:

(all previous books, plus) Ezekiel, Daniel, Hosea, Joel, Amos

Be ready to recite:

*The Sixth Commandment*

You shall not commit adultery.

*What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we lead a chaste and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.

## Wednesday, October 23

have read: Genesis 32-35, 37

be ready to recite all the books of the Bible:

(all previous books, plus) Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk

Be ready to recite:

*The Seventh Commandment*

You shall not steal.

*What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.

## Wednesday, October 30

have read: Genesis 39-41

be ready to recite all the books of the Bible:

(all previous books, plus) Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi, Matthew

Be ready to recite:

*The Eighth Commandment*

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

*What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.
